December Term 2022 Course Descriptions

CCA 213 Mindfulness Meditation – Online Hybrid – Required Zoom sessions 11/30, 12/7, 12/14 from 6-8pm

Research shows that mindfulness cultivates skills to manage stress and build attention, focus, and resilience. This experiential course is an introduction to mindfulness. Through it, students will learn the principles of mindfulness, develop their practice, and apply the skills to their daily life. Students will learn strategies to skillfully develop their capacity to enhance mind-body awareness of present-moment experience. These practices have many benefits, such as improving health and wellbeing, deepening relationships, and enhancing engagement in learning, work, leisure, and civic activities.

The class is taught in a secular manner drawing on western modalities of neuroscience and psychology, as well as Zen Buddhism. Students will study theory and research in the field of mindfulness and the emerging science that shows the beneficial effects on physical and mental health and well-being.

This two-credit online class will consist of five modules, three required Zoom sessions, readings, journal keeping, mindfulness practice sessions, and a personal mindfulness project.

CCA 216 – Holiday Films – Online Asynchronous – Course runs 11/28 – 12/16

This course uses the holiday genre to introduce students to a range of perspectives from which to interpret and analyze films and other popular media. Using a selection of screenings and accompanying readings, students will identify the characteristics of the holiday genre, paying particular attention to the role of tradition and to the relationship between the individual and the community. They will also consider the broader cultural contexts of these films, analyzing them from historical, business, and ideological perspectives. By the end of this course, students will have gained confidence in employing critical approaches to media analysis, while interpreting and appreciating a diverse selection of holiday films and “very special” TV episodes.

There will be no required textbook for this course, but students will be asked to rent films and/or view them on a subscription streaming service like Netflix.

Winter Term Course Descriptions

CCS 220 – Fashion and the Environment – First Five Weeks (1/2/23 – 2/5/23)

This 5-week course introduces students to the concept and science of sustainability, its relationship with the business of fashion, and strategies and work practices to shift the business to a sustainable operating mode. Coursework topics focus on defining sustainability, understanding human-induced climate change, and local and global effects that fashion has had on the Earth and its peoples. Learners will examine the impact of supply chains and apply sustainability practices to create an action plan for a fashion company. The course is self-paced and includes a pre-assessment test and modules of interactive instruction based on asynchronous lectures, videos, interactive exercises, case studies and knowledge assessments.

CAN 300 – Cannabis, Race and Justice – Course runs all quarter – (1/2/23 - 3/19/23)

This course investigates issues related to race and equity in the recreational cannabis sector. It examines the impact of, among other issues, the industry's commercial landscape and concerns about 'Big Cannabis' as an emerging yet not universal corporatized model, cultural proclivities toward natural and preventive medicine as well as race-related disparities in the cannabis universe. The latter includes a focus on the various regional strategies to resolve disproportionate, race-based arrest and incarceration rates pre-legalization, social equity and licensing programs for cannabis entrepreneurs, teenage marijuana use and the overall state of numerous social justice movements to address these and other racial issues connected to this industry.

CCA 357 – Cathedrals of England: A Pilgrimage – Study Abroad – visit: [Study Abroad](#) to apply by November 15 – Travel 3/15/23 – 3/20/23. More info contact SCPS International: scpsinternational@depaul.edu

This study abroad program brings students to England – London, York, Canterbury, and other sites – to experience among the most impressive medieval cathedrals in the world. The travel segment is designed as a pilgrimage to the cathedrals because that is how people in the Middle Ages visited them, but also because that form of travel was, like the Silk Road, an early form of international commerce. As with globalization today, medieval pilgrimage involved people bringing not just goods but ideas across national borders, irrevocably impacting and being impacted by the cultures through which they traveled. As with pilgrimage, students in this program will share a collaborative journey of discovery and cultural exchange as they engage with England's medieval past and its post-Brexit present. For SCPS Undergraduate students: Each course counts toward one of the following learning requirements: LEX, CCA, CCH, PSGP, IN.
